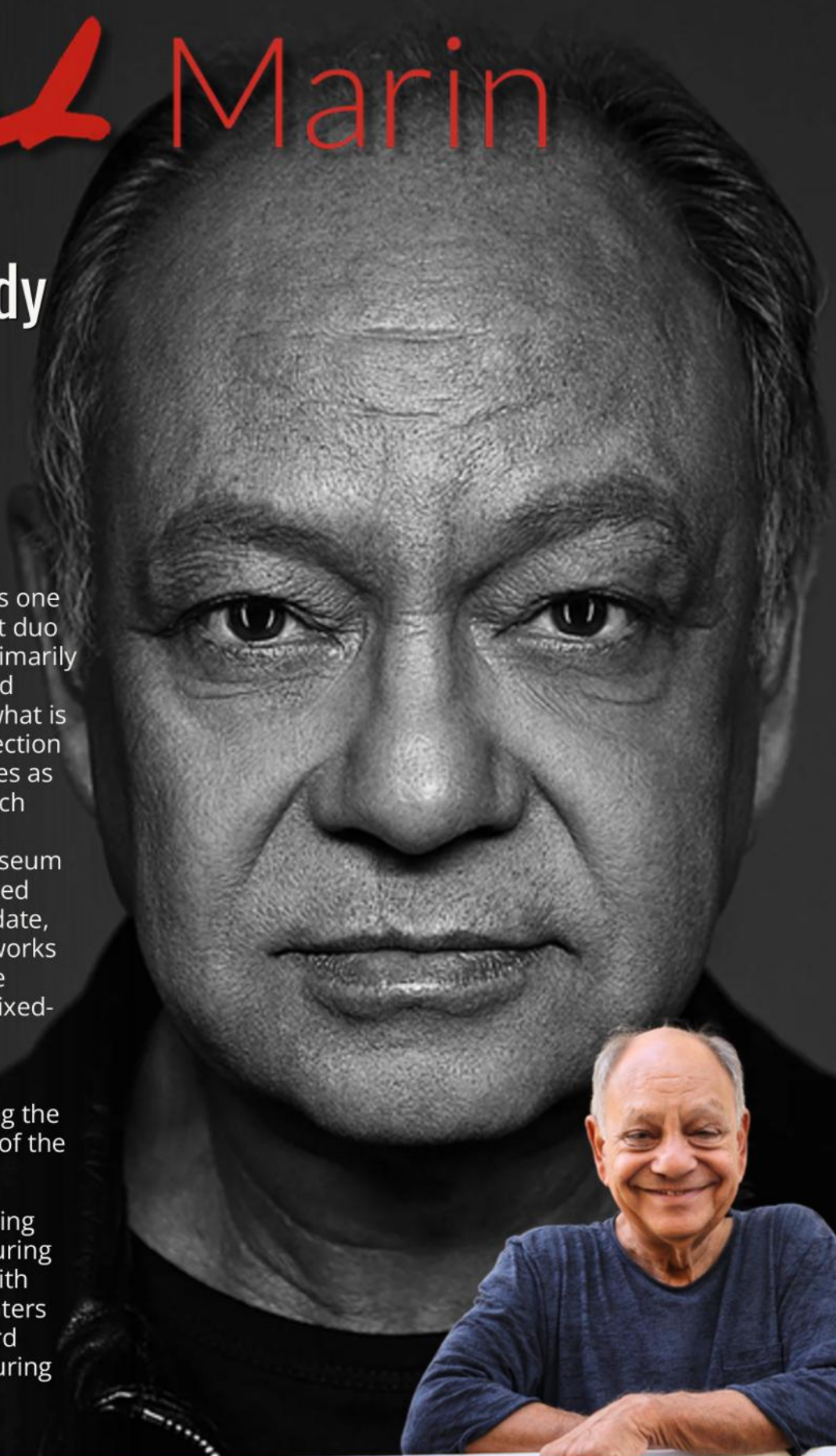

Cheech Marin is best known as one half of the hilariously irreverent duo of Cheech and Chong. While primarily known as an actor, director, and performer, he has developed what is arguably the finest private collection of Chicano art, which now serves as the core collection of The Cheech Marin Center for Chicano Art & Culture of the Riverside Art Museum founded in 2022. Since he started collecting in the late 1980s, to date, he has accumulated over 700 works of art; the majority of which are paintings followed by prints, mixed-media works, and sculptures.

Marin declares, "Chicano art is American art. My goal is to bring the term 'Chicano' to the forefront of the art world."

This objective led to his producing and touring of exhibitions featuring works from,, starting in 2001 with Chicano Visions: American Painters on the Verge, which drew record attendance at the 15 venues during its six-year national tour.

Don McLean is a GRAMMY Award honoree, a Songwriter Hall of Fame member, and a BBC Lifetime Achievement Award recipient. His smash hit "American Pie" resides in the Library of Congress National Recording Registry and was named a Top 5 Song of the 20th Century by the Recording Industry of America (RIAA).

Don McLean, a New York native, is one of American history's most revered and respected songwriters. After paying his dues in the New York club scene in the late 1960s, he went on to score mega-hits like "Vincent (Starry, Starry Night)," "Castles in the Air," and many more. His catalog of songs has been recorded by Madonna, Garth Brooks, Josh Groban, Drake, "Weird Al" Yankovic, and countless others. In 2015, McLean's handwritten manuscript of "American Pie" lyrics was auctioned by Christie's, selling for just over \$1.2 Million. Don was honored with a star on the Las Vegas Walkway of Stars, and his song "And I Love You So" was the theme for Prince Harry and Megan Markle's wedding.

Together, his achievements and timeless songs solidify Don McLean as one of the most influential and enduring voices in American music history.

Doug Smith served as a wildlife biologist at Yellowstone National Park for nearly three decades and studied everything from beavers to birds. Most importantly, he led the Yellowstone Wolf Project, which reintroduced gray wolves to the park. He's written numerous scientific publications and has been featured in four National Geographic television specials. He has also written and edited several books about the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem, including the 2023 book: *Yellowstone's Birds: Diversity and Abundance in the World's First National Park*.

Yellowstone National Park contains many stories, including one of the best-case studies in wildlife conservation. This program explores how the landscape has changed since the wolves arrived, including never-before-seen photos and videos of the quest to bring back this apex predator.

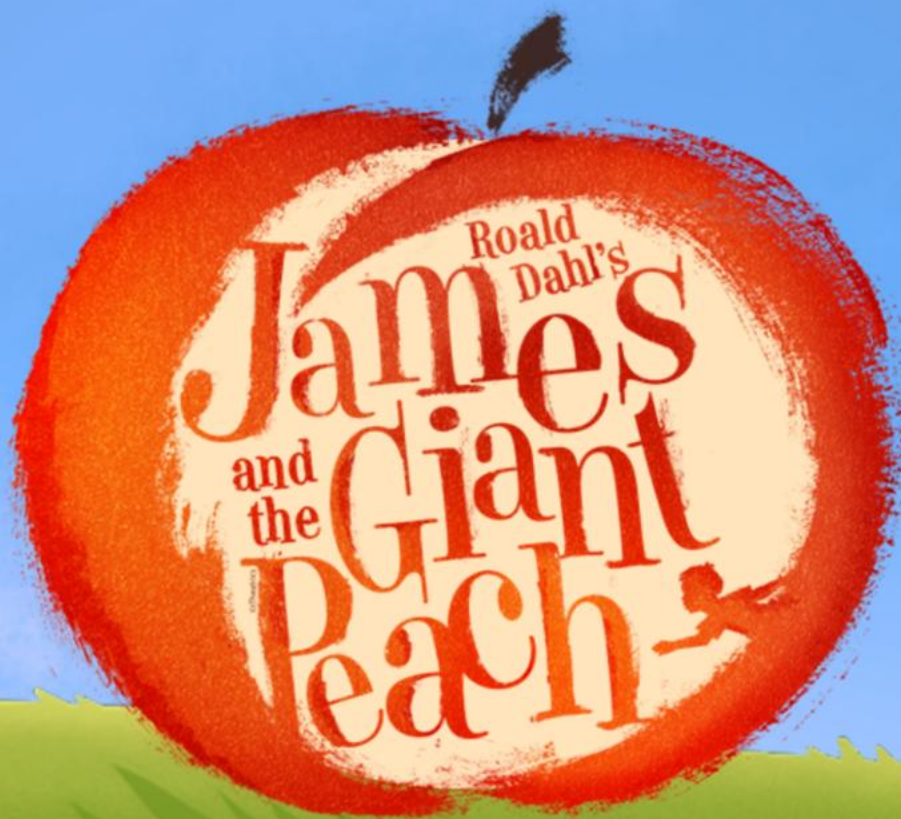

Formed in Austin, Texas, **Fastball** rose to prominence in 1998 with the release of *All the Pain Money Can Buy*. The album went platinum and produced the breakout hit "The Way," a chart-topping single that earned Grammy nominations and became a defining track of late '90s alternative rock.
